

A14 Cambridge to Huntingdon, Cambridgeshire: major improvements

Construction work on the new A14 Cambridge to Huntingdon scheme is underway. We are currently carrying out a variety of tasks for which we need to close lanes or carriageways on the A1, A14 and some local roads at times, usually overnight between 8pm and 6am, unless otherwise stated. A clearly signed diversion route will always be in place for closures.

For this week, the planned closures are:

Full closures

Monday 10th (one night)

- A14 westbound Brampton Hut junction 21 to Ellington junction 20

A signed diversion will be in place. Vehicles will follow the A14 link road at junction 23 to travel north on the A1(M) then travel west on the A605 to re-join the A14 at junction 13

Non motorway traffic west at Wooley Road, south on Ellington Road and west at Wooley Hill to re-join the A14

Monday 10th to Tuesday 11th (two nights)

- A14 eastbound between junctions 26 and 31

Strategic traffic will be diverted south on the A1198, then east on the A428 to re-join the A14.

Access for local traffic will be maintained between the hard closure and the strategic diversion

Monday 10th to Thursday 13th (four nights)

- A14 eastbound Ellington junction 20 to Brampton Hut junction 21

A signed diversion will be in place. Vehicles will travel east on the A605 then south on the A1(M) to the A605 to re-join the A14 at junction 22. Non motorway traffic will be diverted east at Wooley Hill, then north on Ellington Road and Wooley Road to re-join the A14.

Monday 10th to Friday 14th (five nights)

- A1 northbound between Buckden and Alconbury
A signed diversion will be in place; Vehicles will travel east on the A428, north on the A1198, west on the A14 and then north on the A14 link road to re-join the A1

- A1 southbound between Alconbury and Buckden

A signed diversion will be in place. Vehicles will be diverted south on the A14 link road, then east on the A14, south on the A1198 and west on the A428 to re-join the A1

Wednesday 12th (one night)

- A14 westbound between junction 31 and junction 27

Vehicles will be diverted west on the A428 then north on the A1198 to re-join the A14 at Godmanchester

Local access will be maintained between the strategic diversion and the hard closure

- A14 eastbound junction 29 exit slip to junction 29 entry slip
Vehicles will be diverted via an 'up & over' closure via the roundabout
- M11 junction 14 to A14 westbound

Thursday 13th (one night)

- A14 eastbound between junction 26 and junction 31

Strategic traffic will be diverted south on the A1198, then east on the A428 to re-join the A14.

Access for local traffic will be maintained between the hard closure and the strategic diversion

Friday 14th 9pm to Monday 17th 6am

No access to through-traffic on the A14 at junction 29 both eastbound and westbound due to Bar Hill bridge decks installation. Strategic traffic will be diverted at junctions 24 and 31. Local access will be maintained between the strategic diversion and the hard closure.

- A14 eastbound between junction 29 and junction 30

Vehicles leaving junction 29 wishing to head towards Cambridge will be diverted west to junction 24, south on the A1198 at Godmanchester then east on the A428 to re-join the A14 at Girton

- A14 westbound junction 31 exit (westbound to westbound loop)

Vehicles will be diverted west on the A428 then north on the A1198 to re-join the A14 at Godmanchester

- Hilton Road

Saturday 15 8am – 5pm

- A1 southbound Brampton exit & entry slips and Brampton Road
